I would like to introduce you to Miss Yasmin Assar who wants to collect used eyeglasses for the Georgia Lions Lighthouse for the Blind.

She will be doing this project under the auspices of the North Decatur Lions Club.

The Lighthouse is located on Clairmont Road in Decatur, and collecting used eyeglasses is one of its projects. Last year more than a hundred thousand pairs were collected, sorted, washed, read and tagged by volunteers.

If the glasses are badly scratched or the frames broken they are recycled for their metal content. The Lighthouse received a check for a little over \$5000.00. The money is used for sight services here in Georgia.

In 1925 Helen Keller asked Lions Clubs International to become her "knights of the blind in the crusade against blindness." Sight is still our major interest at home and abroad, and we appreciate Miss Assar's desire to volunteer her time and effort to this project.
